

THE CLIFFORD DALE WUNSCH MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

The Clifford Dale Wunsch Memorial Scholarship was established as an on-going memorial and tribute to Clifford Dale Wunsch, who passed away in March of 2003.

Cliff was well known and respected in the agricultural industry throughout the country, having been involved in agriculture since his early childhood. After working on the family farm, Cliff began his agricultural career as a custom harvester for wheat growers in the Midwest.

Cliff then pursued a career in the agricultural equipment business, working as a sales manager for Sperry New Holland in Chandler, Arizona and then Tulare, California. Cliff was transferred to Stockton, California in 1972, after being promoted to store manager. Cliff started the first New Holland store in Stockton on Navy Drive and then spearheaded the move to its current location on West Charter Way.

In 1979, Cliff established his own business in Stockton called Big W Sales. This new endeavor brought Cliff into the fertilizer and spray application business. Under Cliff's direction, Big W Sales expanded their operations to include facilities in Yuma, Arizona and Fresno, California. Today, Big W Sales has become one of the leading distributors of fertilizer and spray application equipment and accessories in the country.

Throughout the years, Cliff was a strong supporter of the agricultural community. As chairman of the Greater Stockton Chamber of Commerce agri-business project committee, Cliff was instrumental with helping start the Stockton Ag Expo in 1975. Cliff was also a strong supporter of 4-H, donating his time and resources to the local 4-H program for several years.

Cliff was an active member of Lincoln Presbyterian Church for over thirty years.

As an on-going tribute, the Wunsch family has established this memorial scholarship to honor the life of Clifford Dale Wunsch.

THE CLIFFORD DALE WUNSCH MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

As an on-going memorial and tribute to Clifford Dale Wunsch, the Wunsch family has established the Clifford Dale Wunsch Memorial Scholarship for the purpose of providing financial assistance to students who seek a career in the agriculture industry. Two \$2,500.00 scholarships will be awarded annually.

Under the guidance and participation of the Wunsch family, the Clifford Dale Wunsch Memorial Scholarship is administered by the SJFB Foundation for Agricultural Education, a non-profit educational organization.

Eligibility Requirements

- Applicants must be entering or attending an accredited junior college or four-year university in California with a majority of their study in agriculture.

Application Requirements

- Application and supporting documentation must be postmarked or physically delivered to the San Joaquin Farm Bureau Federation Office no later than March 2, 2012.

- Two letters of recommendation must accompany the application.
- A one-page essay must accompany the application.
- Official (certified) transcripts must accompany the application.
- Print or type legibly.
- Applications submitted without ALL requested documents will not be considered for selection.
- Do not include any material other than the materials that have been requested.

Selection Criteria

- Demonstrated desire and commitment to pursue a career in the agricultural industry.
- Demonstrated need for financial assistance to fulfill educational goals.

Distribution of Funds

- The recipient will be presented a certificate recognizing the award at the San Joaquin Farm Bureau Federation's Annual Meeting tentatively scheduled for May 11, 2012. Attendance is mandatory.
- Upon receipt of a certified document reflecting the recipient's enrollment as a full-time student in a junior college or four-year university, the scholarship check will be sent to the recipient's college, which can be used for tuition, books, or other academic costs.
- Failure to enroll in a junior college or university in the fall of 2012 may result in forfeiture of the award.
